

A structure at the site emits large quantities of smoke through the roof, and many pieces and remains of splintered metal, wood, etc. are associated with the smoke; there are large vigorous flames at the base and mixed in with the billowing smoke. Impression that the attack involves the air--i.e., that it came by way of the air in some way. Impression that it came from over a large area of high ground to the lower right (perhaps the SSW) of the site. Structure involved is a dark, neutral color, and complex--with tall parts, corners, alcoves, frameworks, and steps. (ADL Bk Ship) Structure viewed from top after incident reveals billowing dark smoke, licking flames, twisted distorted structural components, debris, very large ragged gap in roof. People outside, dismayed, disoriented, others moving towards for damage control/recovery/rescue. Strong ADL/D of Pearl Harbor.
